

### Questions and Answers:

Q.) When do I need to fill out a building permit with the city?

A.) Building permits are required on all projects including construct, alter, repair or move a building. Here are some examples: new shingles, or windows, replacing deck, updating a kitchen or bathroom, adding on to existing structure, sheds, or a fence. They are reviewed at the monthly City Council meeting. You can find the form on the website or call the office at 678-2409.

Q.) I understand that "Gwinner's Police" is the Sargent County Sherriff's Office, but how do I get ahold of them if I need them?

A.) In emergency you should always dial 911. Non emergency and during office hours (9-4:30pm) you can call 707-724-3302 or

after hours you can call state radio at 1-800-472-2121.

Q.) How long can a car, trailer, camper, four-wheeler or a boat be parked on a city street?

A.) 72 hours or it can be towed at owner expense.

Q.) When will the city fall maintenance projects be?

A.) SOON, this will effect everyone! Which includes cleaning sewers and manholes and flushing water mains. For more information please look on the website or call the city office.
